

## Volunteer Role Description

### Role Title:

Transport Volunteer

### How you can make a difference:

All groups need a volunteer who helps by collecting and distributing equipment and supplies to other volunteers and helps cats get from A to B, this role does just that! This role plays an important part in providing support to other volunteers, enabling them to carry out their roles effectively to help cats in our care.

### What the role involves:

- Collection and delivery of funds raised by the group.
- Transporting equipment, litter and cat food.
- Transporting cats to and from vets, fosterers' homes and adoption centres.
- Transporting equipment to and from events.

### Skills and experience required or could be developed:

- Sound organisation and time management skills.
- Knowledge of local community.
- Full, clean driving licence.
- Physically able to carry out some heavy lifting.

### Expected time commitment:

This is a flexible role with time commitment dependent upon needs of volunteer group, a commitment of 2 to 4 hours per week would not be unusual. This role can be shared with other volunteers.
