ABOUT OUR BRANCH

- We cover the M11 corridor from Saffron Walden to Woodford Green.
- Founded in 1993, we home about 150 cats and kittens a year.
- We can advise on what to do if you lose your cat.
- We can help with neutering costs for cat owners on low incomes.
- We will try to help if you want us to take a cat in, although at times we have a waiting list and have to give priority to urgent cases.
- We provide information on cat care.
- We can talk to school and community groups about our work.

HOW WE ARE FUNDED

We raise most of our income from donations, membership fees, cabin sponsorship and fundraising events. We also receive a small annual grant from the national organisation on a discretionary basis.

SUPPORT US

Branch membership is available at £10 a year (£6 senior citizens, £15/£9 joint membership at same address). You don't have to be a member of the national Cats Protection organisation.

Your subscription will fund the cats in our care, going towards food, vet bills, and transport costs. It will help pay for our neutering work. You will receive a regular Newsletter on what we do and other feline matters.

ADOPT A CAT or KITTEN

Our cats are cared for to Cats Protection's strict standards, and before homing are vet-checked, vaccinated, microchipped,wormed and deflea'd. The adoption fee includes 4 weeks' free insurance.

Our adult cats are neutered, and you must agree to have your kitten done when old enough. Help with neutering costs is available in cases of financial hardship.
