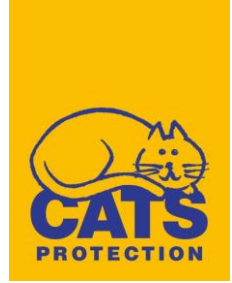


## Cats Protection – Gifts in wills suggested wording



With any matter regarding your will, Cats Protection always recommends that you seek professional legal advice, but the following suggested wording will assist your solicitor in drawing up or amending your will.

### Residuary gift

The gift of a proportion or the remainder of your estate, after all the other gifts have been allocated and all costs have been paid. This type of gift is often particularly valuable to a charity like Cats Protection as its value will increase in line with the value of your estate.

*I give (..... per cent) of the residue of my estate both real and personal to Cats Protection, National Cat Centre, Chelwood Gate, Haywards Heath RH17 7TT, Registered charity number 203644 (England and Wales) and SC037711 (Scotland), for their general purposes and the receipt of the proper officer of the charity shall be sufficient discharge for my Trustees.*

### Pecuniary gift

The gift of a specific sum of money.

*I give to Cats Protection, National Cat Centre, Chelwood Gate, Haywards Heath RH17 7TT, Registered charity number 203644 (England and Wales) and SC037711 (Scotland), the sum of ....., for their general purposes and the receipt of the proper officer of the charity shall be sufficient discharge for my Trustees.*

### Specific gift

The gift of a particular item.

*I give ..... to Cats Protection (Registered Charity Numbers 203644/SC037711) of the National Cat Centre, Chelwood Gate, Haywards Heath RH17 7TT for their general purposes and the receipt of the proper officer of the charity shall be sufficient discharge for my Trustees.*

### Leaving a gift to a branch or adoption centre

Some supporters chose to remember a specific branch or adoption centre in their will. Others chose to leave their gift for the benefit of their local area. The following wording is designed to help you do this; your professional legal advisor will be able to help you fill in the details to fit your wishes.

*I give to Cats Protection, National Cat Centre, Chelwood Gate, Haywards Heath RH17 7TT, Registered charity number 203644 (England and Wales) and SC037711 (Scotland), the sum of ..... and I express the wish but without creating a binding legal obligation that the legacy be used for the benefit of the ..... branch and the receipt of the proper officer of the charity shall be sufficient discharge for my Trustees.*

## **Cats Protection to act as Executor of your will**

“I appoint Cats Protection Trustee Ltd of Cats Protection (Registered Charity Numbers 203644/SC037711) of the National Cat Centre, Chelwood Gate, Haywards Heath RH17 7TT to be Executor of this my will”

## **Cat Guardians**

If you would like Cats Protection to care for, and rehome your cat(s) in the event of your death, you will need to include the following in your will:

*My Executors should contact Cats Protection, National Cat Centre, Chelwood Gate, Haywards Heath RH17 7TT, Registered charity number 203644 (England and Wales) and SC037711 (Scotland), to arrange for the care of any cats that I may own at the time of my death.*
