## What to do if your cat/kitten goes missing

Cats Protection recognises how distressing this can be. You may find the following check-list a convenient way to prioritise the options you have in seeking to recover your pet.

# <u>Look In</u>

- cupboards
- boxes
- washing machines etc
- sheds and garages
- vehicles
- all rooms
- gardens, hedgerows watch for snares,
- Lost and Found section of the local newspaper

# <u>Inform</u>

- local veterinary surgeons
- local schools
- local Branch Cats Protection
- SSPCA
- the cleansing dept. of your local council
- your postman and milkman

# <u>Advertise</u> (Including a photograph of your missing cat/kitten)

- distribute leaflets to shops, Post Office, garages
- local schools
- local newspapers
- local notice-boards
- posters on trees and other suitable sites
- Pet Search Tel.01387 250999 (local radio)

### Offer a Reward

If you offer a reward say 'Large Reward'. The word 'large' is relevant, and what is small to you might be large to another person or child.

## **Finally**

The earlier you report your cat/kitten as missing, the more likely it is that he/she will be found.

## Remember

To inform any authorities who have been asked to look for him/her if your cat/kitten returns home.
