## Looking to adopt a cat? Here's how our new homing process works

### 1. Check if your local centre is taking part

You can find your nearest centre using our Find Us tool at [www.cats.org.uk/find-us](http://www.cats.org.uk/find-us) where you'll find some of our cats ready for adoption.



### 2. Enquire

Found a cat you'd like to offer a permanent home? Hit the 'contact us' button to fill out the details in our home finder form.



### 3. Reserve

If you're an ideal match, let's have a chat! We'll arrange a virtual meet-up to find out more about you and your home. You'll also have the chance to discuss everything you need to know about your new arrival – from what they eat to their favourite toys.



### 4. Adopt

Once you've paid your adoption fee over the phone, we'll officially sign the cat over to you. We'll then arrange a driver to safely bring your cat to your home.



### 5. Feel supported
