



# Lost your cat? Follow our checklist

- Search first. Check small spaces in your home – everywhere from cosy cupboards to garden sheds, garages and outbuildings
- Ask your neighbours.  
They'll need to check their property, sheds and garages too
- Is your cat microchipped? Talk to Petlog on 0844 4633 999 to register your cat missing
- Speak to your local Cats Protection branch or centre. To find one in your area, visit [www.cats.org.uk/find-us](http://www.cats.org.uk/find-us) and enter your postcode
- Get in touch with animal shelters in your area.  
Visit [www.catchat.org](http://www.catchat.org) to find those local to you
- Contact all local vet practices in the area
- Make and put up flyers with your cat's photo and description to place around the local area
- Post a description on your Facebook page, as well as any local community Facebook groups
