| Search first. Check small spaces in your home – everywhere from cosy cupboards to garden sheds, garages and outbuildings              |

| Ask your neighbours.<br>They'll need to check their property, sheds and garages too   |
| Is your cat microchipped? Talk to Petlog on 01296 737 600 to register your cat missing  |
| Speak to your local Cats Protection branch or centre. To find one in your area, visit www.cats.org.uk/find-us and enter your postcode |
| Get in touch with animal shelters in your area. Visit www.catchat.org to find those local to you                                      |
| Contact all local vet practices in the area   |
| Make and put up flyers with your cat's photo and description to place around the local area   |
| Post a description on your Facebook page, as well   |
