Oxalis (wood sorrel, shamrock)

Caution advised

Achillea (yarrow, milfoil, carpenter's weed)

Bindweed (*Convolvulus, calystegia sepium*)

Bird's foot trefoil (*Lotus corniculatus*, eggs and bacon, birdsfoot deer vetch)

Creeping buttercup (*Ranunculus repens*)

Daisy (*Bellis perennis*)

Enchanter's nightshade (*Circaeа lutetiana*)

Evening primrose (*Oenothera biennis*)

Giant Hogweed (cow parsnip, *Heracleum mantegazzianum*)

Green alkanet (*Bugloss, Pentaglottis sempervirens*)

Ground elder (Bishop's weed, gout weed, *Aegopodium podagraria*)

Groundsel (*Senecio vulgaris*)

Knapweed (*Centaurea nigra*)

Lesser celandine (*Pilewort, Ficaria verna*)

Red clover (*Trifolium pratense*)

Scarlet pimpernel (*Anagallis arvensis*)

Sorrel (common, spinach dock, garden, *Rumex scutatus*)

White clover (*Trifolium repens*)

Safe for cats

Bittercress (*Cardamine hirsuta*, mustard family)

Cleavers (sticky willie, goosegrass, *Gallium aparine*)

Common chickweed (winter weed, chickenwort, *Stellaria media*)

Common mouse ear (*Cerastium alpinum*)

Couch (Twitch, scutch, *Elymus repens*)

Creeping thistle (*Cirsium arvense*)

Cuckoo flower (*Cardamine pratense*)

Herb Robert (red robin, storksbill, *Erodium cicutarium*)

Horsetail (marestail, *Equisetum arvense*)
