Cheques should be made payable to Newbury Cats Protection. **Please include your name, contact telephone number, and the cat's name on the reverse of each photo. Closing date for entries is 24th August 2012.**

Unfortunately, photographs can only be returned if a stamped addressed envelope is supplied with your entry(s) or are collected from the adoption centre after the event.

Copyright of all photos will remain with the photographer but, by signing the entry form, the photographer allows Newbury & District Cats Protection to reproduce such photographs without further permissions or payment in the calendars, newsletters or on the website.
