Why complete your Pre-clinical EMS placement with CP?

At our adoption centres (AC), student vets will have the opportunity to gain a whole host of skills and experiences as part of their placement while making a huge difference to cats and kittens.

You can complete a minimum of two weeks with Cats Protection and will be supported to develop many fundamental skills and knowledge you need to succeed and make this placement a great start to your veterinary career.

You will develop animal handling, husbandry and communication skills. You will be introduced to CP's minimum veterinary standards (MVS) and the principles of shelter medicine and learn about the importance of kitten neutering and population control. You will get the chance to meet and learn from our amazing team and will also have access to Cats Protection's online learning platform and resources on topics such as cat behaviour, infectious diseases and their control, cat care and welfare and our *Veterinary Guide*.

Key Pre-clinical EMS activities at Cat's Protection

- Understanding of veterinary standards in shelter medicine
- Understanding of the shelter environment and facilities including disease control and cat safety ie different areas of the AC and pen design including our admissions, isolation and homing areas
- Handling of a variety of cats and kittens
- Observing cat behaviour in a shelter environment
- Understanding nutrition and carrying out day-to-day feeding
- Carrying out grooming and play
- Encouraging the socialisation of kittens
- Carrying out day-to-day cleaning to increase understanding the importance of shelter hygiene, the impact of infectious diseases and the correct and safe use of disinfectants
- Understanding regulations regarding waste/medicine storage and disposal
- Working and communicating with a wide variety of people ie volunteers, staff, vets, vet nurses and members of the public
